PROFILE.....

KRISHNA KANTA HANDIQUI PRIMARY, HIGH SCHOOL (ENGLISH MEDIUM)

World famous scholar ideologist and philanthropist from Assam, Krishna Kanta Handiqui was a recipient of the civilian honour of the Padma Shri and Padma Bhushan. He was born in 1898. His father was Radhakanta Handiqui and his mother was Narayani Handiqui. He was not only a worthy son of his parents but also of Assam. "Morning shows the day" – this proverb was quite applicable in case of Krishnakanta Handiqui. Being born in an aristocratic family, he had every opportunity to spend time in luxury, but instead, he remained busy in study from his childhood. Sanskrit Literature specially attracted him. While reading in class ten he finished reading great Sanskrit works like Meghdoot, Raghubasham, Kumar Sambhav, etc.

He passed the HSLC examination in first division in 1913 and started his higher education in Cotton College, Guwahati from the same year. He was specially inspired by the contiguity of Dr. Banikanta Kakati and Dr. Surya Kumar Bhuyan. During his study in Cotton College, he finished reading the great Sanskrit epic Naisadhacarita of Sriharsa. By virtue of his deep integrity in study he accomplished the nearly impossible task of translating the unfathomable epic Naisadhacarita of Sriharsa into English with explanatory notes which was published twenty years later. He passed his IA examination in 1915 from Cotton College and got himself admitted in Sanskrit College, Calcutta for graduation. He completed it with flying colours. Besides receiving a first class BA degree with honors in Sanskrit he was also awarded with the prestigious "Prasanna Kumar Sarbadhikari Gold Medal" and a scholarship of distinction. He did his MA degree from Calcutta University in 1919 and got First Class First position in Sanskrit.


His great thirst for knowledge led Krishna Kanta Handiqui to visit foreign countries to study for long seven years in universities like Oxford, Paris, Berlin etc. During this period, he learnt many foreign languages like French, German, Latin, Greek, Italian, Russian etc. He concluded his studies in Oxford with great repute; in 1923 acquiring first class Master's degree with honors in "Modern History".


Returning from abroad, he became the founder Principal of Jagannath Barua College and contributed immensely to make it a leading educational institution of Assam. Krishna Kanta Handiqui was the President of 17th conference of Asam Sahitya Sabha in Guwahati in 1937 at a young age of 39. Handique was the founder Vice-Chancellor of Gauhati University for nine years (1948–57). During this tenure he ensured to make it one of the most reputed universities of the country. Handiqui was posthumously awarded the sahitya Academy Award in 1985.

His literary achievements have made him immortal and world famous. He was honoHis literary achievements have made him immortal and world famous. He was honoured "Prachyavidyarnava". He was awarded with "Padmashree" and "Padmabhushan" by the Government of India. Gauhati University and Dibrugarh University awarded him with D.Lit degrees. "Earthly achievements are nothing more than air breathed out" - this was his philosophy of life. In spite of his leading a family life, this rare talent, like a sage, was able to roam in the depth of Indian Culture and Philosophy by virtue of which he accomplished his three major works namely "Naisadhacarita", "Yaśastilaka" and "Setubandha". These contributions have established him in high esteem amongst the intelligentsia of the world. This great man breathed his last on 7th June, 1982.

Named after this versatile genius and towering personality Krishna Kanta Handiqui Junior & Degree College and krishna Kanta Handiqui Primary, High School (Assamese Medium) came into being at the heart of Pathsala under Barpeta District to commemorate the values and journeys explored by this scholar of worldwide fame. In the year 2016, KRISHNA KANTA HANDIQUI PRIMARY, HIGH SCHOOL (ENGLISH MEDIUM) was our another step in the field of education as a result of the response from learned society. The institution sincerely aims at imparting quality education to the students and also at propagating them as proper human resource which has been of utmost necessity in the present context to heal the ailing society and the world as well.

The School is run and managed by 'NEW AlKIDO' Society, an NGO bearing registration no. RS/BAR/237/T/34-2015-2016 and follows the NCERT pattern of syllabus from Class- I onwards.
